ROM the moment you step into Le Français French Dining, you will notice its cosy ambience, stylish table settings and perfect colour scheme.

They are ideal for a wonderful dining experience.

Here, traditional and contemporary French cuisine is the order of the day.

Jerome Deconnick, the head chef/director said his greatest pleasure was to get people to appreciate French food.

"I make sure the quality of service here is the best. We serve simple food but all the ingredients are fresh. There is also a wide selection of French wines." said Deconnick.

Jerome, who is from the southern part of France, started cooking at 14 and has been in Malaysia for nearly seven years.

So you bet he knows what he's doing.

The menu is written in French with English translations.

For starters, you should try poached egg nested on brioche with red wine sauce, candied shallots and oyster mushrooms at RM25. Or the dill scented salmon tartar with candied tomatoes at RM30 per serving. For the main course, walnut crusted lamb chop with candied garlic and bohemian vegetables at RM68 is an ideal choice.

If you're more into fish, try the grilled sea bass fillet served with saffron flavoured tomato puree and roasted baby leek at RM46.

Finally, end up your meal with grand marnier soufflé at RM34 or chocolate fondant with tea sauce and strawberry salad at RM30. They go best with a cup of coffee.

Le Francais French Dining is open everyday except on Tuesday.

On Monday, Wednesday and Thursday, the place is open only for dinner from 7pm-10.30pm while on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, it's also open for lunch from noon to 2.30pm.

For lunch, you have the choice of a two course menu at RM50++ or a three course menu at RM70++. Dinner is only available on an a la carte basis.
